



Celebrating the talent around Eastover, 2020

→ Open to the first 60 students in grades K-3 who submit their completed permission slips by February 27th. Each member in a group counts as a student. Incomplete submissions will not be accepted. Permission slips will be available in the office if you're not able to print this.

~Any 3rd grade student who wants to be an MC can participate by announcing an act (and performing if they choose). Permission slip required to be a MC.

The following are guidelines to submit an application to participate in the show.

- 1) Permission slips will not be accepted electronically (via fax or e-mail).
- 2) If the act includes more than one student, all students in that group must submit their slips attached together and each one must be filled out completely to be accepted.
- 3) If any information is missing from your permission slip it will be returned to you the next school day to be completed and you can resubmit thereafter (your entry will be counted when all information is completed).
- 4) Students will be notified via e-mail after the first 60 completed permission slips are received. No information will be available before then.

Auditions:

(must be in line by 6:00p)

Eastover Gym (These are very quick auditions, we only watch a small portion of the acts)

- **Students must be accompanied by an adult to audition.**
- **If a student is coming from latchkey, they must first be signed out by an adult and then attend the audition with an adult.**
- **Audition only needs to be 30 seconds or less.**
- **Students must have their music (2 min or less) sent to Mrs. Crocker via apple music link, mp3 link or google link along with any lyrics in typed format at the audition to participate. If you have any questions about the appropriateness of lyrics, please get approved by Mrs. Crocker prior March 11th.**
- **Parents are responsible for any props needed for their child's act at dress rehearsal and the day of the performance. This includes tables, chairs, etc. Mats are available on the side of the stage. Contact Andria Trumble andria.trumble@gmail.com if you are in need of something, she can assist you. ☺**
- **Students must be available on the nights of the audition and dress rehearsal to participate. Due to the amount of scheduling conflicts for people, we cannot honor specific performance request times. We appreciate your understanding.**

The talent show is for entertainment purposes only. We will not be awarding prizes. Students may perform in one act only. Each act can be no longer than 2 minutes. Singers must sing a cappella (no music) or to instrumental music ONLY. Singing along to a vocalist's (karaoke) is not permitted unless it's part of a larger act (dancing, playing an instrument, etc.). **Music must be sent via link/file for auditions. Lyrics to ALL music that will be played at the talent show MUST be in typed format and handed in at the audition along with music link. All content/lyrics will be approved by Mrs. Crocker.**

You must wear the clothes or costume you plan to wear in the show, at the dress rehearsal on March 25th. Eastover student dress code applies to the talent show. Shorts~not too short and not too tight (fist by your side rule). Shirts~not too short and no bare midriffs. No spaghetti straps. MUSIC AND ACTS MUST BE APPROPRIATE--IF YOU ARE UNSURE, ASK MRS. CROCKER FIRST. Mrs. Crocker reserves the right to have final say in all lyrics, clothing and acts.
