<u>Teacher Conferences and Report Cards:</u> Parent/Teacher Conferences are held in September, November, and April. Report Cards are posted online in January and June.

<u>Lunch Debit Cards</u>: In previous years, pre-covid, debit cards have been used to purchase lunch, beverages and snacks. No cash was accepted in the lunch line. For this school year, there will be no debit cards needed to obtain a lunch, and all school lunches will be free for all students. If your child does not want a school lunch they are still welcome to bring in a lunch and snack from home.

<u>Check Writing</u>: As mentioned above, when writing checks to the school for any reason – filling lunch accounts, event attendance fees, yearbook or Spirit Wear orders, field trips – you will always make the check out to "Bloomfield Hills Schools," and make sure you put your child's name, and the purpose for the check in the Memo. For example, if this is for your child's lunch account make sure to write "lunch account" in the memo line.

Food at Lone Pine

Food is not permitted at any event held during school hours. This is due to the increased number and variety of life-threatening food allergies in the school. Events and parties are extremely enjoyable for our students, but do not center on food items.

Food is permitted at PTO-sponsored events held before/after school hours, where parents are in attendance with their children.

Lone Pine is a **nut-restricted school**, and we ask parents to adhere to this policy when packing your children's school lunches and snacks. This means all varieties of nuts, all the time. Selected classrooms may have additional food restrictions. Your child's teacher will advise you as needed.

If you would like to celebrate your child's birthday at school, consider donating a book or game to your child's classroom. Contact your child's teacher for further instructions. Birthday treats are not allowed. Lone Pine students and teachers appreciate the additions to their classroom libraries and indoor recess game collections! Make sure you write your child's name and birthday inside the book/game you are donating so that they can be remembered for years to come.

Events:

Welcome Back Coffee – After you say goodbye to your kids, on the 1st day of school, join us for coffee and to mingle with other parents outside.

Back to School Pizza Party and Movie Night – Hope you will join us on Friday, Sept 10 at 6:30 pm! This is a wonderful way to kick off the school year, meet our teachers, and get to know other families.

Bingo Night – An evening of bingo, dinner and prizes. Bingo Night is a Lone Pine tradition, and it is lots of fun!

Book Fair – Week-long event where Scholastic Books are available for sale. The children will create wish lists for books they would like to purchase, and there will be several opportunities throughout the week for parents to come in and shop with them.

Bus Driver Fuel Up – Thank you receptions held for our wonderful bus drivers.

Curriculum Night – Beginning of the year evening for parents to get to know their child's teacher, and hear about what they will be learning throughout the year.

Donuts with Dudes – Kids can bring their favorite dude for a before school treat and activity.

Fun Run – One of our largest school fundraisers. The kids run laps around the lower fields in order to earn pledges that go towards supporting Lone Pine's PTO.

Halloween Bash – Held on a Friday night the week before Halloween at West Hills – Dress in costume, and come celebrate Halloween with the entire Lone Pine community.

The party will begin with Trunk or Treating in the parking lot. There will be dancing, dinner, treats and fun for all!

Kindergarten Playdate – Held before the start of school, this event is a great opportunity to meet our Kindergarten teachers and other families.

Pistons Night – Come cheer on the Pistons with your Lone Pine friends. Kids will even get to participate in a fan experience!

Special Persons Day Picnic – Your kids will enjoy a picnic lunch with a special person in their lives.

Spirit Days – Students can show their weekly school spirit by dressing in either Lone Pine Spirit Wear, or our school colors (blue and green), each Friday. On the last Friday of each month, however, students will have fun dressing according to that month's changing theme – for example, Mismatch or Crazy Hair Day. Sometimes money is raised for a good cause on these days, other times it is just to show school spirit together.

Spring Carnival – This carnival brings together the entire school to celebrate the end of another marvelous year together. Carnival games, inflatables, dinner, face painting, treats – it's such a good time!

Teacher Appreciation Week and Dinners – This one week in the spring provides a chance for the PTO and families to thank our unbelievable teachers and staff for all that they do for our children.

Third Grade Clap Out – This takes place on the last day of school, a clap out ceremony is held for 3^{rd} graders to wish them well as they are exiting Lone Pine to begin their journey at West Hills.

Third Grade Party – This party celebrates our graduating 3rd graders.

School Programs:

Assemblies – PTO brings some excellent and interactive assemblies for the entire school. From STEM to a traveling Detroit Opera House children's group to assemblies on historical figures – we bring new assemblies to the school each year that our kids love taking part in.

Author/Artist Visits – Both authors and artists are brought in by the PTO to share their work and creative process with the students.

Box Tops – Download the app Box Tops for Education on your smartphone and start scanning your grocery receipt for all the grocery box top items you purchase!! This committee monitors Box Tops collected throughout the year to raise money for Lone Pine. Raffles and contests are held, and students can win prizes and class parties for participating.

Bulletin Board – Check out our PTO bulletin board, outside the school office, information on current PTO programs and events.

Classroom Photographers and Room Parents – We will be looking for the following for our classrooms this year: 1 Classroom Photographer to make sure great pictures and moments are captured for the annual yearbook; 1-2 Room Parents to work with their classroom teacher to coordinate volunteers, class projects, and distribute information to families. Specialist Room Parents will also be needed to help our Art, Music, P.E., Spanish, and Media Center teachers.

Family Connection - A Lone Pine/West Hills Middle School parent group designed for international families, families new to the district, or anybody who wants to make new friends. Monthly meetings will help families make connections, provide support, and answer any questions about the schools, area resources, or culture.

Hospitality – Providing snacks and drinks at many of our PTO events held over the year.

Junior Achievement – Kindergarten through 2nd grade students receive an education in economics during the spring. Volunteers are needed in each classroom to teach this topic in an age-appropriate and creative way.

Math Pentathlon – Interested students participate in interactive problem-solving games that strengthen basic math problems and skills, and stimulate creative thinking ... all while having fun with their peers! The program runs throughout the year, and culminates with a spring tournament.

School Beautification – Making the school a beautiful and welcoming place to be. This committee often works in conjunction with the Michigan Green School Chairperson.

School Store -3^{rd} graders will participate in an optional monthly seminar teaching them about economics, customer relations, product selection, the importance of supporting local businesses, and creativity. 3^{rd} grade students and parent volunteers will then implement these teachings by running Lone Pine's School Store for the remainder of the year.

Spirit Wear – Show your school spirit by purchasing various Lone Pine items for sale to raise funds for the PTO.

Student Action Team – Student representatives are chosen per class to learn about important community organizations and issues, and they relay these messages back to their classmates. The kids organize collection drives and bring awareness to the school. Several groups are formed, during the year, allowing different students to participate.

Yearbook – End of year publication, available to purchase, highlighting that school year's special moments.

Committee Representatives:

Allergy Awareness – Parent volunteers dedicated to the safety of our student population and raising awareness regarding food allergies.

BHS Foundation - Parent volunteer who serves as a liaison with the BHS Foundation

Global Education Team– Parent and teacher representatives serve on the district's committee that ensures Bloomfield Hills Schools are equitable and inclusive, and that our students are given the proper tools to be members of a meaningful global society.

Leadership Team – Parent volunteer who serves on a faculty committee that oversees curriculum, programs, and the school's Primary Years Program.

Legislative Representative – Parent volunteer who keeps the school informed about relevant/current educational state legislation.

Michigan Green School: Parent volunteer who works with teachers and the principal in order to prepare and submit the Michigan Green School application - for designation as an "Evergreen" Michigan Green School.
