GRANTS AND PROGRAM FUNDING

The BHSF awards Educator Grants twice a year. These grants inspire and enrich initiatives in academics, STEAM, diversity, the arts, special education, and more. This school year, we awarded more than 40 grants across the district. Every school received at least four grants. Our 2018-19 grants ranged in amount from \$200 to \$3000. Overall, we funded over \$38,000 in grants and programming initiatives this school year.

Some highlighted grants include:

Turing Tumble: Marble-powered computers for Physics classes (BHHS)

Refugee Stories: An interdisciplinary study to help understand the current refugee crisis. (WHMS)

Finding our Faces in Books: Diversifying a Classroom Library (Eastover)

Bloomfield Winter Park: A revitalization of the Farm Activities Building for community gatherings at Bowers Farm. (District-wide)
