2017 Oakland County Fair Prep Program-Kathleen Blust-Bowers Farm/4H

Greenhouse and Butterfly Garden-Erin Watson-East Hills Middle

Supplies to update and repair the existing greenhouse and courtyard space and planting materials to create a butterfly garden.
