GRADE POINT AVERAGE

The grade point average on a transcript is not weighted if a student has taken an Advanced Placement (AP;IB) and/or select honors (HON) course. A "G" grade indicates a passing grade in a pass/fail option. An "H" grade indicates fail. An "S" grade indicates the course was retaken for grade replacement. The lowest grade one can earn and still receive credit is a D-.
